



GUIDELINES FOR TRASH & RECYCLABLES

Trash: *Use Colored Bags*

- Sharp, bulky items do not need to be bagged. Place next to bags on edge of road.
- Tie bags using corners

Recyclables: *Use Clear Bags*

What to collect:

- Relatively clean glass bottles
- Relatively clean plastic bottles
- Relatively clean aluminum cans
- Relatively clean steel cans
- Paper products & cardboard (if not too contaminated)

What to avoid:

- Extremely dirty bottles & cans
- Broken glass
- Filling the bags too full or with too many heavy materials

Recyclables that will be picked up if placed next to bags:

- Tires
- Old appliances
- Car batteries

Leave all collected materials in a visible area anywhere along the edge of your assigned road!



- Newspapers
 - Magazines and catalogs
 - Junk Mail
 - Cardboard and paperboard boxes
 - Corrugated boxes
 - Computer printouts
 - Books (including paperback, textbooks)
 - Brown paper bags
- Telephone books
 - Glass food and beverage containers
 - non-metallic wrapping paper
 - aluminum food and beverage containers
 - Empty aerosol cans
 - Wide-mouth containers such a peanut butter/ butter tubs
 - Milk/ juice cartons

Leave all collected materials in a visible area anywhere along the edge of your assigned road!
